

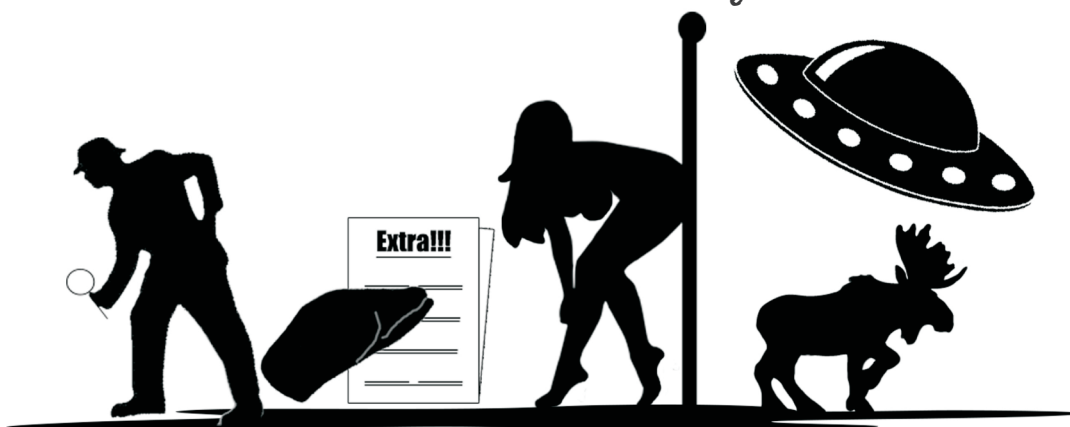

**DIRECTOR:** Suzanne King

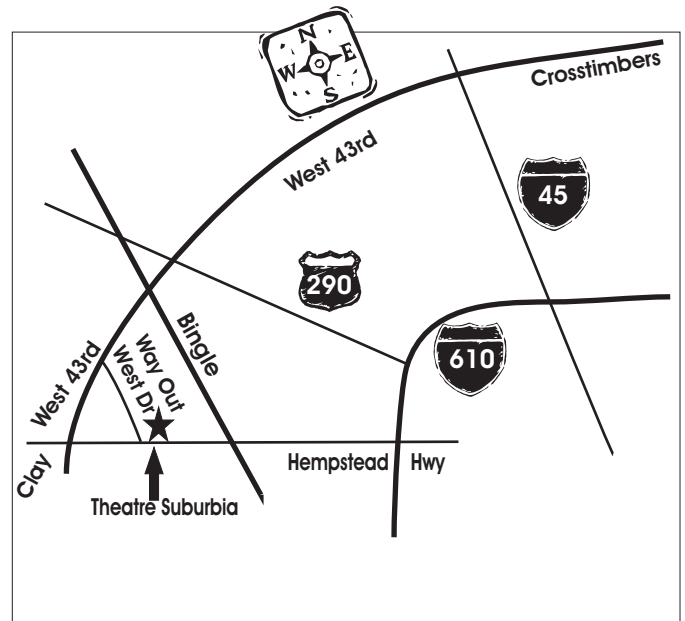
